



MONITORING CORONA-VIRUS SELF-TESTS ON COMPANY PREMISES

About



Under the new ordinance issued by the Federal Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs (BMAS), companies are to offer coronavirus self-tests to their employees who do not work exclusively from home offices. The aim is to break the chain of infection. To achieve this goal, the coronavirus self-tests must be performed reliably and applied correctly. For this reason, many companies would like their own employees to motivate and help their colleagues during the self-tests application.

Technical requirements: Participants do NOT need to install any software, they simply get into the virtual classroom via a link. They will need: PC with at least Windows 7, Apple Mac with at least OS X 10.8, in each case with sound card/sound output and connection for a headset // Headphones with microphone (headset), webcam // Internet access with at least 0.6 Mbps downstream and at least 0.2 Mbps upstream (in your router or under settings/network speed) // Current version of an HTML5-browser (e.g. Chrome, Firefox, Edge).
